

## RULES OF PLAY

1. Play is best ball scramble for all teams. Teams choose their best and all players drop a ball to that spot and shoot from within one club length – no closer to the hole. The lie may not be improved, e.g., from the rough to the fairway
2. A & B flights are for men, MX are for co-ed, and L flights are for women teams. A & B flights are determined by the previous year's scores.
3. Men and women will compete separately on Longest Drive and Closest to the Pin. However, they will compete together on Straight Shooter and Longest Putt. Prizes will be awarded to each winner at dinner.
4. All men will tee off from blue/white tees. Women will tee off from the tee of their choice. Seniors (65 and over) may play from senior tee if they choose to do so.
5. All putts must be putted out (no "gimme" putts).
6. All ties will be decided by #1 handicapped hole and so on.
7. All USGA rules apply regarding penalties, etc....
8. Please respect other players and the course. Replace all divots and repair all ball marks.
9. 90-degree rule will be in effect, please observe.

## CONTEST HOLES

### LONGEST DRIVE – Hole #18

- Drive must be in the fairway to qualify.

### CLOSEST TO THE PIN – Hole #2

- Tee shots only. Ball must stay on the green to qualify.

### STRAIGHT SHOOTER – Hole #10

- Closest to the line wins with the distance breaking ties.

### LONGEST PUTT – Hole #7

- The longest putt from the green which goes in the hole wins.

## VEGAS HOLES

### CLOSEST TO COOLER – Hole #17 – \$5.00 / Shot

- Tee shot closest to the cooler wins. Ball does not need to stay on the green.

### 50/50 – Hole #6 – \$3.00 / Shot

- Win a 50/50 raffle ticket by landing on the green.

### HIGH ROLLER – Hole #11 – \$5.00 / Shot

- One shot, ball must be on the green. Odds are determined by roll of dice.
